

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEDIAS, TEXAS, ADDING  
TO THE CITY OF BEDIAS CODE OF ORDINANCES: PROVIDING RESTRICTIONS  
ON PRIVATE USAGE OF ALL CITY RIGHT-OF-WAYS.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 51.001 of the Texas Local Government Code, the City Council of the City of Bedias may adopt or amend ordinances for the good government, peace, or order of the City of Bedias or for the trade and commerce of the City and that are necessary or proper for carrying out a power granted by law to the City or to an office or department of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds it is necessary to add an ordinance regulating and/or restricting the use of right of ways within the city limits of Bedias and requiring anyone using or blocking the city right-of-ways to remove all items to provide safety and protection to the citizens and infrastructure of the City of Bedias.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEDIAS, TEXAS;**

**Section1:** The rules, regulations, terms and conditions, provisions and requirements of this ordinance are hereby found to be reasonably necessary to protect the citizens and infrastructure of the City of Bedias.

**Section 2:** It is hereby ordered that any items blocking or restricting access to any right-of-way within the City of Bedias must be removed by the owner or at the owner's expense if the city must move it. Anyone needing to store or place items on any city right of way, must have it approved by council first.


**Section3:** This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage.


